- All performances were presented in Marathi, reflecting pride in our traditions and values.



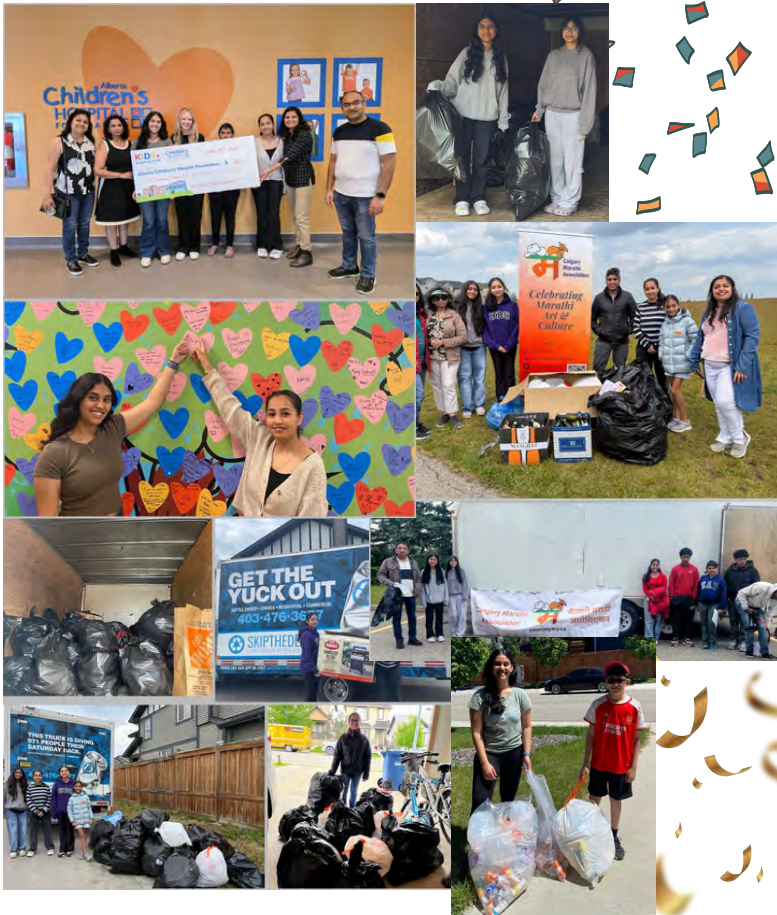
- For 2024 - 2025, we had 70+ Marathi Shala Students.

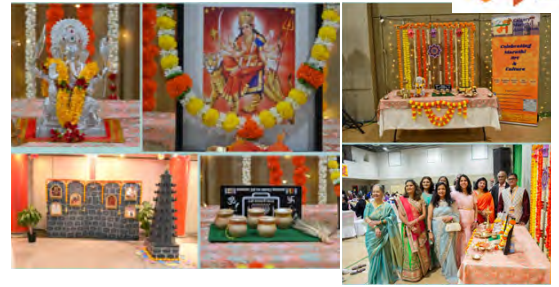
**Deepavali Faral Making Sessions**
